Below are examples of previous successful submissions.

## Queensland - Rugby Union

### What items are you requesting?

80 sets of uniforms. 4 sets of team kits. Under 7's - mixed gender. Under 9's - mixed gender. Under 11's - mixed gender. Under 13's - gender split. These will be kept as club uniforms and reused for the next few years.

### Tell us WHY you need these items? Please be specific.

Our club does not currently have any junior team uniforms to play games in. Going into our second season we have focused on providing equipment to training venues, which are 110km apart. In our first season, we attracted 80 participants but could only provide equipment to keep costs low. This year being our first year of competitive games with other local associations, will see us borrow uniforms from other local teams from outside our sport until we can financially gain our own or from a grant such as this.

### Tell us what difference these items will make to your club or community. Please be specific.

To create a sense of pride, accomplishment and commitment, our players need a uniform to represent. With a fee to cover the cost of venue hire, insurance and training shirt, a club based uniform will create a sustainable resource to our club without adding additional costs to families who already are required to travel up to 200km to train and up to 500km to play. A set of team uniforms will make our sport attractive to others as they see a visible representation and opportunity to play.

## South Australia - Football Club

### What items are you requesting?

Additional team equipment for new teams, ball packs, bags, soccer goals, training bibs and training equipment.

### Tell us WHY you need these items? Please be specific.

The Club created a GOALS FOR GIRLS program. This was an introduction to soccer program with a focus on skill development in a fun and friendly environment. The Club ran and subsidised the 5-week event to promote girls in soccer over August-September. As a result of this we are looking to grow from 26 to 40+ girls next year. This could include an additional U7 team, an U8 team and possibly a U10/U11 team. With this increase in players comes equipment required.

### Tell us what difference these items will make to your club or community. Please be specific.

This grant will have a major impact on our club. With growth comes the requirement for new and additional equipment, this grant with the provision of equipment will free up much needed funds to increase community engagement programs. It will provide the club with opportunities for further reduction in fees to incentivise engagement in our club and develop a love of the sport. Importantly, it will enable the children and their families to be positively engaged in sport and physical activity and have positive impacts on our wider community.
